The Graduate School of Informatics (GSI) at Nagoya University, Japan, is pleased to announce an opening of the following position. GSI was established in 2017, specializing in informatics to promote research and to train informatics professionals.

1. Position title: Professor

3. Teaching subjects:  
Graduate-level: “Advanced lecture on global media and communication”, “Seminar on global media communication”, “Social informatics”, etc.  
Undergraduate-level: “Lecture on media systems”, “Information and the international society”, “Research seminar on social informatics”, “Information and profession”, “Informatics 2”, “Introduction to social informatics”, “Bachelor’s thesis”, “English or German as a foreign language”, etc.
4. Qualifications:  
Applicants are required to:
  - (1) hold a Ph.D. in media and communication studies, political science and related fields in social sciences;
  - (2) be able to teach undergraduate- and graduate-level courses and supervise theses/dissertations of master’s and doctoral students in Japanese;
  - (3) be able to collaborate with the Global Media Research Center (GMRC) for research projects;
  - (4) be ready to work with governmental organizations and private companies including newspapers and TV stations for research projects, lectures and seminars.
5. Documents to be submitted for application
  - (1) Curriculum vitae with a passport-size photo attached; an e-mail address should be included
  - (2) List of publications (books, book chapters, peer-reviewed articles, conferences proceedings, academic presentations and etc.)
  - (3) Copies of up to five main works (photocopies are acceptable). At least one main work should be written in English.
  - (4) Summary of previous research achievements and future research plans (two to three pages)
  - (5) Essay on previous educational achievements and future plan on education (one

page)

(6) List of awards, grants, scholarships and activities in academic organizations, and information on social activities

(7) Names, affiliations, and e-mail addresses of two contact references

(1) Short-listing based on application documents

(2) Interview and/or a short lecture
