The International Programs of Nagoya University Graduate School of Medicine seeks to fill a full-time, non-tenure-track, Designated Assistant Professor position regardless nationality for research and teaching Graduate Courses in Medical Science. Our program is interested in recruiting a scholar with efficient English language ability, high research ability, education experience and enthusiasm about teaching and administrating the International Program in Comprehensive Medical Science as a joint degree program with foreign Universities. This program offers the opportunity for graduate students in International Program in Comprehensive Medical Science to take coursework in English. It aims to foster qualified researchers in interdisciplinary medical sciences having research ability in both clinical and basic research work. The successful candidate will teach within our program offerings courses. As a full-time faculty, s/he will be expected to hold office hours, provide academic advising for students and perform the normal duties associated with research and teaching.

Minimum Qualifications

- 1) Doctoral degree in Medical Science or a related field with teaching experience
- 2) Demonstrated ability to advise students at the undergraduate and graduate levels
- 3) Take an active part to participate widely in the International Programs of the university including but not limited to teaching courses to Japanese students and some administrative duties
- 4) Strong inter-personal skills and evidence of effective interaction with students, faculty, administration, and community
- 5) English fluency to effectively teach or support abovementioned courses

Preferred Qualifications

- 1) Experience working in a multicultural environment preferred
- 2) Japanese language proficiency is welcome though not required

The contract will be starting 1 April 2018, and terminating 31 March 2019.

Salary: Salary will depend on qualifications and experience, based on Nagoya University's Salary Rules for Employees to whom the Annual Salary System applies. *Taxes and insurances will be withheld from the annual salary.
