

Job Opportunity for Tenure-Track Assistant Professor (non-PI) at Division of Biological Science, Nagoya University Graduate School of Science

Outline: Nagoya University Graduate School of Science will recruit a tenure-track assistant professor “Jokyo” specialized in plant cytoskeleton and cell division for the Group of Intracellular Dynamics, Division of Biological Science.

Number of positions : 1 Tenure-Track “Jokyo” (non-PI [principal investigator] assistant professor)

Term: 5 years

Review: Research and laboratory teaching performances will be reviewed in the 5th year. The successful applicant will be promoted as a tenure assistant professor (non-PI position); otherwise employed as a project assistant professor with a term of 1 year.

Qualifications : Holder of a doctorate (Ph.D.) degree (as of March 2019). A good command of English and/or Japanese is required. Experience in cytoskeleton and cell division research using the moss *Physcomitrella patens*, in particular live imaging of microtubule and actin filaments, and microtubule/actin biochemistry, is needed.

Salary/allowances: Annual salary system (to be decided based upon education/employment history, pursuant to the Nagoya University Pay Rules for Employees Covered under the Annual Salary System).

Mission: The applicant will join the group and cooperate with other members for ongoing projects in plant cell division/cytoskeleton. S/he will be encouraged to develop her/his own research project and apply for grants.

received, 4) Research and career plans, and applicant's policy on education, 5) Two contact addresses of the references.

Selection: Applicants who passed the primary screening based upon documents will be invited for a seminar and an interview with faculty members. The recruitment will close when the slot is filled.
