1. Number of Positions: One Professor Position

2. Affiliated Section:

Division of Organic Chemistry, Department of Basic Medicinal Sciences, Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Nagoya University

3. Research Field:

Organic chemistry aiming at the creation of bioifunctional molecules that contribute to the development of medicinal chemistry and life sciences.

4. Qualifications:

Applicant should possess a doctorate degree, have made substantial achievements in the relevant field of study, and have the ambition to pioneer new fields in cooperation with other research laboratories in the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences. In addition, the applicant should be able to teach at the graduate school level, provide research supervision, and take part in administrative tasks at the university with enthusiasm and a sense of responsibility.

5. Subjects responsible for: Graduate School lectures, seminars and so forth. The successful applicant may also be required to contribute to the education program (organic chemistry) of the undergraduate school that has a collaborative relationship with the Graduate School of Pharmaceutical Sciences.

6. Starting date: As soon as possible after September 1, 2019

7. Application documents:

- CV with portrait photo and contact details (address to which the "Notification of Application Results" will be sent, phone number, and email address) [6 copies, photocopies allowed]
- List of research achievements (categorize into the publications for academic society journals or similar (indicate whether they have been peer-reviewed or not), international conferences, books/commentary, patents, prizes and so forth) [6 copies]
- Excerpts of no more than five major papers [6 copies of each, photocopies allowed]
- Summary of research achievements (no more than two A4-sized pages) [6 copies]

- History of external, competitive grants received [6 copies]
- Future aspirations for your research (no more than two A4-sized pages) [6 copies]
- Educational accomplishments and aspirations (no more than two A4-sized pages) [6 copies]
- Two references (provide their names, affiliation, and contact details)

In addition to the documents stated above, please enclose a CD or USB storage devices containing the following files in PDF format:

- A single PDF file containing all of the documents listed above other than the excerpts of major papers.
- If possible, PDF files of your major papers.

8. Application deadline: Applications must reach us no later than Wednesday, May 8, 2019.
