Nagoya University Support Payment for Students Application requirements

1. Eligibility

Among regular students and foreign research students*, those who meet both conditions listed below at the time of application:

(1) Live away from home**. (Those who temporarily went back to their home due to the COVID-19 pandemic are still eligible to apply.)

(2) Do not receive any grant-type financial aid from Nagoya University, governmental entities or private foundations***.

*Regular students of Nagoya University are undergraduate, master's degree and Ph.D. students. Foreign research students are limited to those who hold "Student" as their resident status.

**Those residing in a rental property and not with persons, such as their parents, who support them financially.

***Grant-type financial aid from Nagoya University or governmental entities includes: G30 scholarships, MEXT scholarships, scholarships from foreign governmental entities, JSPS Research Fellowships for Young Scientists, scholarships from JASSO and being currently hired as a RA by the Leading Graduate School Programs or the WISE Programs as a part of their financial support.

2. Number available

Decided by the President of Nagoya University.

3. Cash amount

30,000 yen per student. The student can apply for and receive this benefit only one time during the application period listed below.

4. Selection method

Applications will be reviewed and approved by the President of Nagoya University.

5. Application procedure

Fill out the application form and submit it through NUCT.

6. Application period

Friday, May 8th through Wednesday, June 17th (JST).

7. Payment

When the selection process has been completed, the university will immediately transfer the amount into the applicant's bank account registered with the university. (For example, an account that has been used to receive a TA or RA salary or to fund travel expenses from the university.) For those who have never registered a bank account with the university system, the payment will be made into the applicant's tuition payment bank account with the applicant's prior consent.

8. Others

The university may ask the student to account for how the money was spent.

If the university finds fraud with the application after payment, the student will be compelled to refund the payment and may be subject to disciplinary action or educative measures based on Article 2 item (ii) of the Nagoya University Student Discipline Rules.
