

Use of Dining Hall for Non-Meal Purposes

For the time being, dining halls will be opened for use as a **study hall**

Priority will be given to students using the hall for study purposes, so using the hall for chatting will be prohibited.

- **Available Days: Monday to Friday (Excluding holidays)**
- **Available Hours: Varies by dining hall**

*** Notes on Use**

- **Do not use the hall for chatting.**
- **Please wear a mask.**
- **Please maintain space between seats.**
- **You may talk when you are attending an online class. However, please keep your mask on even when you are talking unless you are instructed to take it off by an instructor during a language course, etc.**
- **Depending on how many people are using the hall, Wi-Fi connections and connection speed may become unstable.**
- **Please follow the instructions of the Co-op staff.**

* From October onwards, there will be occasions where face-to-face classes and online classes take place on the same day. In addition to on-campus open spaces and empty (unlocked) classrooms where face-to-face classes are not taking place, students may use dining halls as access points (places where students can take online classes using Wi-Fi connection).
