名古屋大学における成績評価及び GPA 制度に関する規程

(令和元年 12 月 23 日規程第 68 号)

(目的)

第 1 条 この規程は、名古屋大学通則（平成 16 年度通則第 1 号。以下「学部通則」という。）第 19 条第 7 項及び名古屋大学大学院通則（平成 16 年度通則第 2 号。以下「大学院通則」という。）第 18 条の規定に基づき、名古屋大学（以下「本学」という。）における成績評価及びグレード・ポイント・アベレージ（履修科目の成績の平均値。以下「GPA」という。）制度について必要な事項を定め、厳格かつ適正な成績評価を通じて、教育の質の向上に資することを目的とする。

(成績評価基準、成績評価等)

第 2 条 成績評価に関する記号（以下「評価記号」という。）及び基準（以下「評価基準」という。）並びにグレード・ポイント（各評価に与えられる数値。以下「GP」という。）は、別表のとおりとする。

2 学生が履修した授業科目の成績評価は、法学研究科実務法曹養成専攻を除き、A+、A、B、C、C-及びFの区分による。ただし、この区分により難しいものについては、P及びNPの区分とすることができる。

3 前項による成績評価において、A+、A、B、C、C-及びPを合格とし、F及びNPを不合格とする。

4 Tは、学部通則第 21 条（入学前の既修得単位の取扱い）、第 23 条（他の大学の授業科目の履修等）、第 24 条（留学）及び第 24 条の 2（休学期間中の他の大学の修得単

Rules on Grade Evaluation and the GPA System at Nagoya University

(Rule No. 68 of December 23, 2019)

(Purpose)

Article 1 The purpose of these Rules is to set out necessary matters in relation to the systems for grade evaluation and grade point averages (average score for courses taken; hereinafter the “GPA”) at Nagoya University (hereinafter the “University”) and in doing so contribute to better quality education through strict and appropriate grade evaluations, in accordance with the provisions of Article 19, Paragraph 7 of Nagoya University General Rules (General Rules No. 1 of Academic Year 2004; hereinafter the “Undergraduate School General Rules”) and Article 18 of Nagoya University Graduate School General Rules (General Rules No. 2 of Academic Year 2004; hereinafter the “Graduate School General Rules”).

(Grade Evaluation Standards and Grade Evaluation, etc.)

Article 2 (1) Letters (hereinafter “Grade Letters”) and standards (hereinafter “Grade Standards”) relating to grade evaluations and grade points (the points awarded at each evaluation; hereinafter “GP”) shall follow the Appendix.

(2) Grade evaluations for the courses taken by students shall be classified as A+, A, B, C, C- or F, with the exception of the JD Program for Legal Practice at the Graduate School of Law. However, in cases when it would be difficult to follow these classifications, P and NP classifications may be used.

(3) Under the above grade evaluations, A+, A, B, C, C- and P shall be deemed a pass, and F and NP shall be deemed a fail.

(4) T shall be used in the following cases: when a student has been given credit at Nagoya University for credits acquired at other universities, etc., in accordance with the

2 GPA は、各学期末に算出する。

3 学期 GPA 及び累積 GPA を算出する計算式は、次に掲げるとおりとし、算出された数値に小数点以下第 2 位未満の端数があるときは、これを四捨五入するものとする。

一 学期 GPA の計算式

二 累積 GPA の計算式

(GPA の対象授業科目)

第 4 条 GPA 算出の対象は、卒業要件に算入される全ての授業科目とする。

2 前項の規定にかかわらず、別表に定める P、NP、T 及び W の評価を受けた授業科目

(2) GPA shall be calculated at the end of each semester.

(3) The formulae for calculating Semester GPA and Cumulative GPA shall be as follows.

Calculated numbers shall be rounded to two decimal places.

(i) Formula for Semester GPA

Semester GPA = (Number of credits awarded at A+ in the semester in question × 4.3 + number of credits awarded at A in the semester in question × 4.0 + number of credits awarded at B in the semester in question × 3.0 + number of credits awarded at C in the semester in question × 2.0 + number of credits awarded at C- in the semester in question × 1.0) / (Number of credits awarded at A+ in the semester in question + number of credits awarded at A in the semester in question + number of credits awarded at B in the semester in question + number of credits awarded at C in the semester in question + number of credits awarded at C- in the semester in question + number of credits awarded at F in the semester in question)

(ii) Formula for Cumulative GPA

Cumulative GPA = (Number of credits awarded at A+ × 4.3 + number of credits awarded at A × 4.0 + number of credits awarded at B × 3.0 + number of credits awarded at C × 2.0 + number of credits awarded at C- × 1.0, during the student’s entire enrollment at the University) / (Number of credits awarded at A+ + number of credits awarded at A + number of credits awarded at B + number of credits awarded at C + number of credits awarded at C- + number of credits awarded at F, during the student’s entire enrollment at the University)

(Courses Subject to GPA Calculation)

Article 4 (1) All courses included in calculations carried out for the purposes of meeting graduation requirements shall be subject to GPA calculation.

(2) Irrespective of the provisions of the preceding paragraph, courses receiving an

However, existing precedents shall apply to students who were admitted to the University in Academic Year 2019 or earlier, and to students who are admitted, readmitted, or transferred from other universities in Academic Year 2020 or later to the same year</p>
