The School of Science/Graduate School of Science, Nagoya University, is widely recognized as a leading international center for advanced research and education in the life, natural and mathematical sciences due, in part, to the many distinguished research achievements and talented persons in science and technology that the school has nurtured, including four Nobel laureates: Professors Noyori, Kobayashi, Maskawa and Shimomura, of whom we are particularly proud. In order to cover a broad range of research and educational subjects in the modern sciences, the School of Science/Graduate School of Science closely cooperates with various research centers and organizations within Nagoya University, such as the Institute of Transformative Bio-Molecules (ITbM), Kobayashi-Maskawa Institute for the Origin of Particles and the Universe (KMI), Graduate School of Mathematics, Graduate School of Environmental Studies, and the Institute for Space-Earth Environmental Research (ISEE).

Recently, the Graduate School of Science entered into a Joint Degree Program with a leading European university. A JDP is a single degree program established as an international collaboration between two or more universities. Partner universities of a JDP jointly confer a single degree to a student if the student completes the JDP.

The Joint Degree program (JDP) managed by the Graduate School of Science, Nagoya University, invites applications for a full-time Designated Assistant Professor position for coordinating the program and international public relations for the program and the school.

We encourage applicants who have shown proficiency as a coordinator and excellence in international public relations to apply.

Number of Positions: One

Duties:

- 1) Coordinate the JDP, which is managed by the Graduate School of Science;
- 2) International public relations in English for the JDP, and the School and the Graduate School of Science

Note: You may conduct research activities with an effort ratio of less than 50 percent.

Qualifications:

- 1) Foreign nationality
- 2) Master's degree (if you will conduct research activities, doctoral degree will be preferable.)
- 3) Ability to contribute to advancement of the JDP
- 4) Willingness to engage international public relations
- 5) English fluency sufficient to your duties; Japanese language proficiency at the working level will be welcome.

- 6) Experience in educating students from abroad and in international public relations will be given preference.

Term:

The initial contract will start at the earliest date after September 1, 2021 and terminate March 31, 2022. Contingent upon job performance, the contract may be renewed up to March 31, 2024. The mandatory retirement date of the Nagoya University is the first March 31 after the employee turns 65 years old.

Salary:

4.5 million to 5 million yen per year depending on experience and conforming to the rules of Tokai National Higher Education and Research System.

Documents to be submitted:

- 1) Cover letter
- 2) Full curriculum vitae — please include country of citizenship
- 3) List of research achievements (including published papers, received awards and invited lectures)
- 4) Copies of main article reprints (maximum of 5 papers)
- 5) Statement of philosophy as a faculty member for coordinating the JDP and for international public relations (more than 1 page)
- 6) Summary of work achievements (more than 1 page)
- 7) Proposal for future activities in public relations at NU (more than 1 page)
- 8) Recommendation letter (optional) and personal reference with his/her contact details

Application Procedure:

All applicants should submit their applications **via email**.

All required documents should be combined into one PDF file and sent to “kyouin-koubo@sci.nagoya-u.ac.jp”.

The size of each PDF file must be smaller than 20MB (if exceeded, then send files separately). Write “JDP faculty member (Your name)” in the subject line of the email. After submission, please confirm receipt of the reply email. Please note that we will not consider incomplete applications. Application documents will not be returned.

After screening the submitted documents, only short-listed candidates will be notified for further instructions such as interviews.
