Application Guidelines for Faculty (Nagoya University Main Campus)

Nagoya University offers doctoral programs – the "Transnational Doctoral Programs for Leading Professionals in Asian Countries" – aimed at providing executives of various Asian countries' governments with an education through linking Asian Satellite Campuses with Nagoya University's main campuses and enabling such executives to acquire a doctoral degree and deepen their knowledge and experience while remaining in their current positions.

Nagoya University is seeking full-time faculty for these Programs as follows:

Details

1. Job title / no. of positions: Designated Assistant Professor, Designated Lecturer or Designated Associate Professor, 1 person
2. Affiliation: Nagoya University Asian Satellite Campuses Institute
3. Place of employment: Nagoya University Graduate School of International Development
4. Job description: Working in cooperation with Nagoya University main (Japan) campus academic advisors to give guidance in materials collection, etc. to doctoral (final three-year program) students of the "Transnational Doctoral Programs for Leading Professionals in Asian Countries", as well as assisting, where possible, with guidance in doctoral thesis creation / research guidance and with educational affairs; separate duties may include teaching courses at the Graduate School of International Development.
5. Application requirements:
 - (1) Persons possessing a Master's degree or above (doctoral degree desirable) in international development or a field related to international development and cooperation (academic writing) and on-site research guidance
 - (2) Persons who are able to give sufficient guidance to doctoral students enrolled in the Program in collection of materials relevant to research topics, and to offer them research guidance and assistance in doctoral dissertation writing.
 - (3) Persons who, regardless of nationality, can communicate at an everyday level in the Japanese and English languages
 - (4) Persons with research or practical experience in international development or a field related to international development and cooperation are desirable
6. Employment start period: As soon as possible after April 1, 2022
7. Term of appointment: Until March 31, 2023
(renewable for up to 3 years in principle)
8. Salary / allowances: Annual salary system (to be decided based upon education/employment history, pursuant to the relevant Tokai National Higher Education and Research System rules on remuneration)

9. Application documents:

- (1) CV/Resume (A4 size, with photo attached, including email address. Format not specified)
- (2) Summary of research to date (approx. two A4 pages)
- (3) Plan and aspirations for education/research after appointment (approx. two A4 pages)
- (4) List of research achievements (Japanese-language materials must be listed in Japanese)
 - A. Peer-reviewed articles
 - B. Other articles, book reviews, review articles, commentaries, reports (state whether peer-reviewed or not)
 - C. Books
 - D. Acquisition of external funding like *KAKENHI* (Grant-in-Aid for Scientific Research) for the past 10 years, domestic and overseas conference activities, receiving of awards, invited lectures, academia-community cooperation, and other items worthy of special mention
- (5) Offprints of main articles or papers (up to three in total. Submit e-copies)
- (6) Names and contact information of two persons who can act as reference for the applicant (telephone no., e-mail address)

10. Application deadline: July 16, 2021 (strictly enforced)
