Open Call for a Designated Lecturer at Nagoya University's Institute

for Advanced Research

Nagoya University's Institute for Advanced Research (IAR) was established in 2002 in accordance with the University's Academic Charter ahead of similar entities administered by other universities. The IAR has been designed to proceed with internationally recognized research activities of the highest caliber, to generate distinguished research achievements, and to contribute to society through such commitments. The IAR's main missions are as follows:

- (1)To introduce and share excellent research with members of the University from the perspective of an academy within the University, thereby promoting academic research;
- (2)To promote joint and interdisciplinary research with world-leading researchers;
- (3)To foster young, independent researchers who can serve as trailblazers in their respective academic fields from an interdisciplinary viewpoint; and
- (4)To promote further academic interaction with general research universities around the world through activities as a member of the University-based Institutes for Advanced Study (UBIAS) and contribute to globalization of the University's research.

To fulfill the missions above, the IAR would like to make the following open call for a Designated Lecturer who will be in charge of practical measures in the field of science and engineering. Please note that if applicants are judged as being on the same level in terms of their credentials (including research and educational achievements, social contribution and character), the University will give preference to women.

- 1 Position and the number of job openings: One Designated Lecturer (specialty field: science and engineering)
- 2 Job description: The main responsibilities of the faculty member recruited here is to engage in the administration of the IAR in cooperation with other full-time faculty members (specialty field: Life Sciences, Humanities and Social Sciences), while assisting the IAR Director and Vice Director. The IAR's operations account for approximately 70% of the total effort rate. If some IAR operations overlap with other operations, however, the faculty member is obliged to prioritize the operations for the IAR.
- 3 Application qualifications: Applicants must meet all of the following criteria:

(1)Have earned a doctoral degree or established equivalent research credentials;

- (2)Be equipped with the expertise and abilities (especially English proficiency) to fulfill such university operations as research support, information dissemination, and international interaction;
- (3)Have established excellent credentials in their own research field and also be highly motivated to build and fulfill plans in accordance with the missions of the IAR;
- (4)Have no trouble performing their responsibilities and ensuring communication in Japanese regardless of their nationality; and
- (5)Be able to engage in information-related operations.

4 Employment Period: 3 years from the date of employment However, if employed on or after April 2, 2023, the period will end on March 31, 2026. Scheduled date of employment: As soon as possible on or after February 1, 2023

*Supplementary information

This post will be allocated at the University until March 31, 2026. In the event that the post will continue to be allocated after April 2026, the employment period may be renewed after consideration of performance and other factors. (If renewed, the period will be limited to no more than three years from the date of reappointment.)
