Division of Biological Science, Graduate School of Science, Nagoya University invites applications for one Assistant Professor (tenure-track) for a new group.

1. Open position: Assistant Professor (tenure-track)

2. Affiliation: New group

3. Area of expertise: The new group will start research on protein translation mechanisms using human cells and mice. We are looking for a person who has a background in both molecular biology experiments and bioinformatics analysis, and who is eager to collaborate with other faculty members to conduct research and supervise students' research.

4. Start date: as soon as possible after June 1, 2023

5. Term of appointment: 5 years (Tenure will be granted after screening in accordance with the Regulations Concerning the Tenure Track System of Nagoya University, Tokai National University Organization. For details, please refer to the following URL.

6. Eligibility: Applicants must have earned or expect to earn a doctoral degree by March 31, 2023. In addition, applicants must be able to give lectures in English and speak, read, and write in Japanese.

7. Documents to be submitted:

- (1) Curriculum vitae
- (2) Research history (summary of past research, 2 pages or less)
- (3) List of accomplishments
- (4) Separate volume of major papers (not more than 3)
- (5) Status of research funding
- (6) Research and educational goals after arrival at the position (about 1,000 words)
- (7) Contact information for one referee
- (8) Results of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) or a similar test to determine the applicant's Japanese language ability (for non-Japanese researchers)

(9) Self-assessment of applicability (use Form 1 attached to this application guideline)

8. Deadline: Must be received no later than February 28, 2023 (Tuesday).

9. Submission method and contact information: Please send the above documents (1) through (9) as attachments to the e-mail address below. Please note that for (7), only contact information should be provided, and a letter of recommendation may be sent separately by the recommender within the deadline. The subject line of the e-mail should be “2023 Application for New Group Assistant Professor”. If you do not receive an email confirming receipt, please be sure to contact us. 10. Selection method: After the first round of screening, the remaining candidates will be contacted by the end of March 2023. The second round (interview and seminar) will be conducted after that, and one suitable candidate will be selected.

11. Application instructions: Personal information will be strictly controlled and will not be used for any other purpose or disclosed to any third party not related to the selection process. Application data will be disposed after the selection process. No travel expenses for interviews will be provided.

12. Other: In November 2021, in accordance with the clarification of the scope of control for “deemed exports” under the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act (FEFTA), a part of the provision of sensitive technology to faculty members and students at universities and research institutes has become subject to control under the FEFTA.
