1. Open position: Assistant Professor (tenure-track)

2. Affiliation: Group of Cell Regulation

3. Area of expertise: molecular cell biology, physiology, or neuroscience of mouse

4. Start date: as soon as possible after September 1, 2023

5. Term of appointment: 5 years (Tenure will be granted after screening in accordance with the Regulations Concerning the Tenure Track System of Nagoya University, Tokai National University Organization. For details, please refer to the following URL.

6. Eligibility: Applicants must have earned or expect to earn a doctoral degree by March 31, 2023. Doctoral degree in the life science field and a desire to become an independent Principal Investigator (PI).

The successful candidate will have a strong sense of responsibility and enthusiasm for research and teaching at the graduate and undergraduate levels in collaboration with Professor Kinoshita, Assistant Professor Nishikawa, and other members of the Group of Cell Regulation.

7. Documents to be submitted:

- (1) Curriculum vitae (with photograph)
- (2) List of publications (original papers and other papers should be listed separately)
- (3) Summary of past research (2 pages or less)
- (4) Future research plans (1 page or less)
- (5) Educational experience and aspirations
- (6) Other items of reference
 1. List of awarded research grants
 2. List of invited lectures at international conferences
 3. List of activities at symposiums, workshops, educational courses, etc.
 4. Activities at academic societies, awards received, etc.

- (7) Contact addresses of three researchers who know the applicant well
(including the head of the current organization)
- (8) Five major papers (PDF files)
- (9) Results of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) or a similar test to assess
the applicant's Japanese language ability (for non-Japanese researchers)
- (10) Self-assessment of applicability (use Form 1 attached to this application guideline)

8. Deadline: Must be received no later than April 28, 2023 (Friday).

9. Submission method and contact information: Upload a PDF file containing (1) through (9) above in one file to the JREC-IN Portal Web Application. The JREC-IN system will also be used for Q&A.

10. Selection method: The candidates will be selected based on their application documents, seminar, and interviews. Those who selected for interviews will be notified by e-mail. The results will be notified to all after the final candidate is selected.

11. Application instructions: Personal information will be strictly controlled and will not be used for any other purpose or disclosed to any third party not related to the selection process. Application data will be disposed after the selection process. No travel expenses for interviews will be provided.

12. Other: In November 2021, in accordance with the clarification of the scope of control for “deemed exports” under the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act (FEFTA), a part of the provision of sensitive technology to faculty members and students at universities and research institutes has become subject to control under the FEFTA.
