Responsibilities: In collaboration with Prof. Toshinori Kinoshita, the successful candidate is expected to conduct research to understand the molecular mechanisms of plant response to environmental signals and regulation of plasma membrane H⁺-ATPase. Specifically, the ideal candidate is expected to have experience in conducting research with multi-omics technologies including transcriptomics, epigenomics, and proteomics in stomatal guard cells. Additionally, we are seeking individuals who have experience and enthusiasm in teaching students.
