

## Full Professor or Associate Professor Position in Biology, Nagoya University

Division of Biological Science, Graduate School of Science, Nagoya University is seeking for a Professor or Associate Professors as follows.

### **[Research field]**

We are seeking full professor or associate professors to lead research laboratories from a wide range of fields in biology. While biology exhibits both common principles and diversity, we aim to promote research that falls into either of the following categories: (1) understanding life by exploring fundamental principles shared by all organisms, or (2) deepening our understanding of life as a whole through the study of unique mechanisms in individual species. We are looking for individuals who can contribute to the development of research and education in the Graduate School of Science and the field of life sciences, and who have a strong commitment to interdisciplinary education, specialized education in undergraduate and graduate programs, research supervision, and the management and operation of organizations.

### **[Job description]**

As a Principle Investigator (PI) of the Division of Biological Science, Graduate School of Science, the successful candidate will be involved in research that opens up the frontiers of biology and foster internationally competitive next-generation researchers, as well as education and management in undergraduate and graduate programs and Global 30 Program in cooperation with the faculty members. The candidate should have the enthusiasm and responsibility in liberal arts and sciences education, specialized education in undergraduate and graduate courses, and research supervision in the related research field, as well as management and operation of the relevant organizations.

- 1) Ph. D degree
- 2) Engage in innovative cutting-edge research in the field of biology and be internationally recognized

- 3) Have a track record of being the corresponding author of international peer-reviewed papers and securing research grants that are equivalent to or exceed those of other principal investigators in the same field.
- 4) Be able to teach and guide students in both Japanese and English
- 5) Demonstrate enthusiasm, responsibility, and cooperativeness in teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels (including education in English for foreign students), and possess the ability to guide students towards degree completion
