Climate Science, Atmospheric Chemistry, Atmospheric Environmental Science, Meteorology etc.

◆ Job description

Our group is conducting research on atmospheric aerosols and their climate effects. This position is open to researchers who will conduct research on atmospheric aerosols and their interactions with radiation and cloud processes on a global or continental scale through 1) development and simulations of numerical models, 2) data analysis of observations and numerical model simulations, or 3) atmospheric observations and experiments.

The research topics will be discussed with the applicant, taking into account the applicant's skills and interests.
