Outline

The Institute for Space-Earth Environmental Research (ISEE) at Nagoya University is inviting applications for Designated Professors who will spend one to three months each year at ISEE to research topics related to space and Earth during the fiscal years 2025-2027. ISEE comprises seven research divisions: 1) integrated studies, 2) cosmic ray research, 3) heliospheric research, 4) ionospheric and magnetospheric research, 5) meteorological and atmospheric research, 6) land-ocean ecosystem research, and 7) chronological research. The Designated Professors are expected to engage in interdisciplinary research related to at least one of these divisions and to promote international collaborative research at ISEE. In conjunction with this opportunity, ISEE will hire one full-time postdoctoral researcher for each Designated Professor, with the selection process conducted in consultation with the respective professor.

The appointment is renewable every fiscal year (maximum: three Japanese fiscal years), based on the evaluation of research and other activities at ISEE.
