

Tuition Exemption Due to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

For Nagoya University undergraduate and graduate students (excluding audit students and research students) struggling financially due to the direct or indirect effects of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, Nagoya University will re-open tuition exemption applications and accept those who now meet the standards for tuition exemption.

Selections will be made on the basis of application requirements, sudden changes to household finances, household economic standards, and academic standards.

1. Requirements and standards for application due to sudden changes in household finances

The household income of the individual(s) bearing school expenses must meet both of the following requirements:

- You must submit either a) proof of receipt of national or local government financial support for those who have suffered loss of income due to the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic; or b) document(s) showing that after the event of sudden changes in household finances, household income has fallen to or below half that of the previous year. If submitting proof of receipt of national or local government financial support, document(s) showing current income must also be submitted.
- Nagoya University's usual requirements for tuition exemption must also be met.

2. Documents for application due to sudden changes in household finances

Required documents may differ depending on the application category (general students, self-supporting students, independently financed international students).

Applications for exemption due to sudden changes in household finances are restricted to spring semester tuition only.

Please carefully read the tuition exemption application guidelines before preparing and submitting your documents.

3. Submission deadline

Applications must arrive by 16:00 on Monday, June 15, 2020. This deadline will be strictly enforced.

4. Application and submission procedures

Where you submit your application depends on your undergraduate/graduate school and school year.

Taking into account the Nagoya University Alert Levels in response to the novel coronavirus pandemic, applications will be accepted by mail.

When mailing your application, please make sure to send by simplified registered mail.

Please write on the front of the envelope, "**contains documents for 2020 spring semester tuition exemption application due to sudden changes in household finances**" in red ink.
