3	Details of Application	<p>[Duties (nature of work, subjects in charge, etc.)]</p> <p>The Sustainable Urban Development Course (SUDC) in the Department of Environmental Engineering and Architecture focuses on cities and national land, conducting education and research on technologies and systems for responding to large-scale natural disasters caused by climate change while also reducing the impact on the global environment.</p> <p>SUDC seeks a professor capable of developing the following three areas: tsunami countermeasures for coastal protection facilities in response to natural disasters, coastal erosion reduction necessary for national land conservation, and energy creation technologies such as wave power generation that utilize natural renewable energy.
