SusCode conducts research based on collaboration with actual cities and regions, as well as international partnerships, and play a role in ensuring that research results are returned to education and social contribution.</p> <p>SusCode seeks an assistant professor who has specialized knowledge with one of the following fields: transport planning, transport engineering, urban and regional planning, or decarbonization of transport activity and city.
